The program provides self-paced online learning for individuals, classroom lessons and activities, and community presentation content. Many resources are also available in Spanish.

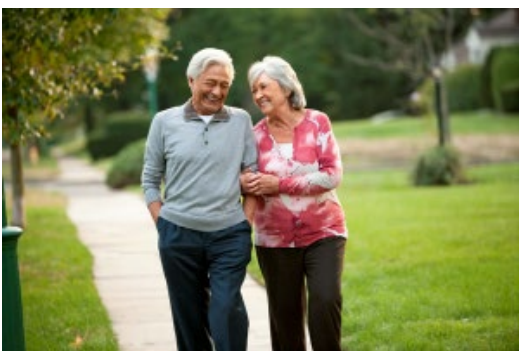

Topics include:

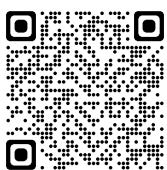
- Banking basics
